**PARM**, through the **IFAD Global Engagement**, **Partnership & Resource Mobilization division** (GPR), has reported back to the G20 as part of its stocktaking exercise during the 1st Agriculture Deputies Meeting held in February in Indore, India. Agricultural Risk Management enables sustainable food systems, increased food security, de-risking investment and improved rural investment along the value chain.



#### Madagascar : Launch of Agricultural Risk Assessment Study by Value Chain

Jointly with the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock of Madagascar, **PARM** is conducting a Risk Assessment Study (RAS) in the country using a holistic value chain approach. The RAS is focusing on **Maize** and **Peanut** value chains as prioritized by the government for **food** and **export crops** respectively. The preliminary results of the RAS will be presented on **5 May 2023** during a technical and knowledge sharing workshop that aims to get local actors contributing to the content of the study. Evidence generated from the study will inform the design of a project on ARM that will contribute to enhance Madagascar's resilience in the era of climate change.

#### Pioneering the Institutionalization of Capacity Development in ARM



To ensure a lasting impact of Capacity Development, **PARM** proposes a pilot test to institutionalize Agricultural Risk Management into the curricula of universities and practices of the private sector. Thanks to PARM's donors funding, PARM was able to collect and analyse the action plans from Burkina Faso and Senegal, and set up a committee to select those for the institutionalisation (INST) pilot phase.
